Consider your (predicted) GCSE grades, interests and future career plans. Choose courses which you will have the entry requirements for.

Students **cannot** take a combination of Level 3 and Level 2 courses.

## Level 3 courses

### Entry Requirements

- Five or more GCSEs at grade C or above, preferably including English and Mathematics.
- Some subjects may require higher grades to ensure that students have sufficient knowledge.
- Please view individual course information for more detailed entry requirements.

### Please choose (circle) three or four of the Level 3 courses

- The columns below show the proposed course option blocks for 2012-13.
- Courses in the same column are taught at the same time so you can only choose a maximum of one course in each column.
- It is expected that all Level 3 students will undertake a minimum of three courses.
- Students who achieve eight or more GCSEs at grade C or above should take four courses.
- Courses will run subject to viable numbers.

\* AS Double Science (Applied) spans across two columns so should be selected in both columns.

\*\* Students who narrowly miss out on GCSE grade C in English or Mathematics are encouraged to retake the qualification so that they are better prepared for future courses and employment. These have a small re-entry fee which is refunded if students achieve a C grade. Students who require the retake GCSEs will not be able to take another subject in that column.
