### **Sevenoaks Christmas Light Switch on**

All secondary schools in the Sevenoaks and surrounding districts have been asked to forward the following message from Kent police:

*Dear parents,*

*We are aware that many young people will be attending the Sevenoaks Christmas Light Switch on, on 30th November 2024. In previous years there has been incidents of violence and underage drinking, which has overshadowed this community event. Police will be in attendance at the event this year and we would like to encourage anyone intending to attend this family event, to do so in a sensible and responsible manner. Any offences and incidents of Anti-Social Behaviour will be dealt with robustly. We hope this event can go ahead, in a manner in which everyone can enjoy.*

*On the date of the event a dispersal order will be in place. This gives police additional powers to move on anyone causing a nuisance and, if necessary, to arrest those who return to the area once dispersed.*

*We would also like to ensure the public are aware that there is a PSPO (Public space protection order), in place at The Vine, Sevenoaks. This gives the Police and the Council the power to issue a warning, or a fixed penalty notice in relation to anti-social behaviour, taking place in the area.*
