Dear Parents,

With the recent warm weather, Chipstead Lakes has become a popular spot for children to meet up and spend time together.

We'd like to remind all local parents that Chipstead Lakes is privately owned. Access is only permitted through the owning business, where appropriate supervision and equipment are provided.

To help keep everyone safe and avoid any issues, please ensure your child understands they shouldn't be visiting the site unless it's arranged through the private business.

It's also important to be aware that open water, such as lakes, can be very dangerous. The water is often much colder than a swimming pool and can quickly affect breathing, heart rate and movement. Entering cold water can cause shock, which may lead to panic and increase the risk of drowning.

Unauthorised access may be treated as trespass and could have consequences, and any reports of anti-social behaviour may result in police involvement. Our priority is keeping everyone safe.
