A few reminders:

Sports Day

A reminder that on Wednesday 15 July, we intend to hold the school Sports Day and would like to extend an invitation to parents of the current Year 7, 8, 9 and 10 students to watch the activities. Viewing is restricted to an area of the field at the top end of the site and no seating is available. I am afraid there is also **no parking available on the school site**; please be considerate towards our residential neighbours if you are parking nearby.

For Year 9 and 10 the event starts at 10.10am to 12.15pm, please do not come on to site before 10.00am

For Year 7 and 8 the event starts at 1.10pm, please do not come on to the site before 1.00pm. At the end of the Year 7 and 8 event parents may, if desired, take their children home with them.

The event requires the assistance of the weather and therefore, if we must cancel on the day, we shall send out a message alert on Arbor and place a pop up on the school website.

On this day students should wear their Knole Academy PE kit or the black t shirt replaced with a house colour T-shirt. **No face/body paint please**; this ends up on walls and sinks and is a nightmare for the cleaning staff.

If they wish, students should bring in some money as Knole Interact will be selling ice poles during the event.
